Wisconsin Coalition of Asian Indian Organizations (WCAIO)

Bylaws

- A. NAME** The name of the organization is Wisconsin Coalition of Asian Indian Organizations (WCAIO)
- B. PURPOSE** WCAIO is a nonprofit nonpartisan organization established as a unified group of representatives from the Asian Indian community and from Asian Indian organizations in the greater Milwaukee Area. Its purpose is to facilitate communication, cooperation and collaboration between Asian Indians and the community at large.
- C. ORGANIZATION**
- 1. Board of Directors**
The governing body of WCAIO will be a Board of Directors composed of one representative from each of the formally established Asian Indian cultural, professional and religious organizations. Additionally the Board will have upto but not to exceede fifteen members on it who may not formally represent any one of the Asian Indian organizations but are able to contribute to the goals of WCAIO. Such Board members will serve no more than two three year terms.
 - 2. Executive Committee**
The Executive Committee shall consist of the President, Vice President(s), Secretary and Treasurer and will be elected by the Board of Directors. The members of the Executive Committee will serve no more than three two year terms.
 - 3. President**
The president will set up agendas, coordinate and chair meetings and establish committees as needed to address various activities of the organization. The president will act as the chief spokesperson for the organization.

4. Vice President(s)

The vice president(s) will assist the president in the implementation of the goals of the organization and will assume the duties of the president during his or her absence.

5. Secretary

The secretary will perform the customary duties of this office. The secretary shall maintain accurate records of the meetings and other proceedings.

6. Treasurer

The treasurer shall perform the customary duties of this office and be co-signatory authority with the president for all financial accounts and activities of the organization.

7. Resignation

A Board member may resign at any time by giving a written notice to the president.

8. Vacancies

Vacancies on the Board of Directors member at large category may be filled by the Executive Committee.

9. Meetings

The Board of Directors and the Executive Committee will meet on a as needed basis.

10. Parliamentary Procedures

Decision making will be by consensus in the spirit of cooperation among members of the Board of Directors unless a vote is called for. In such instances decisions shall be based on majority vote of the members in attendance.
